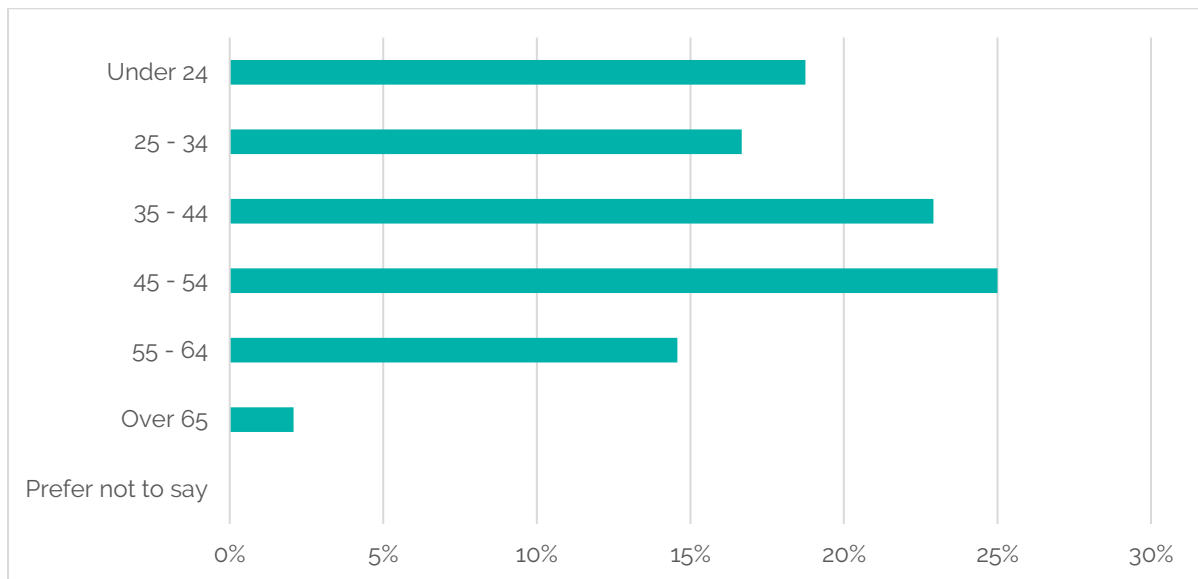
Question 1: Which one category which best describes your role in the firm?



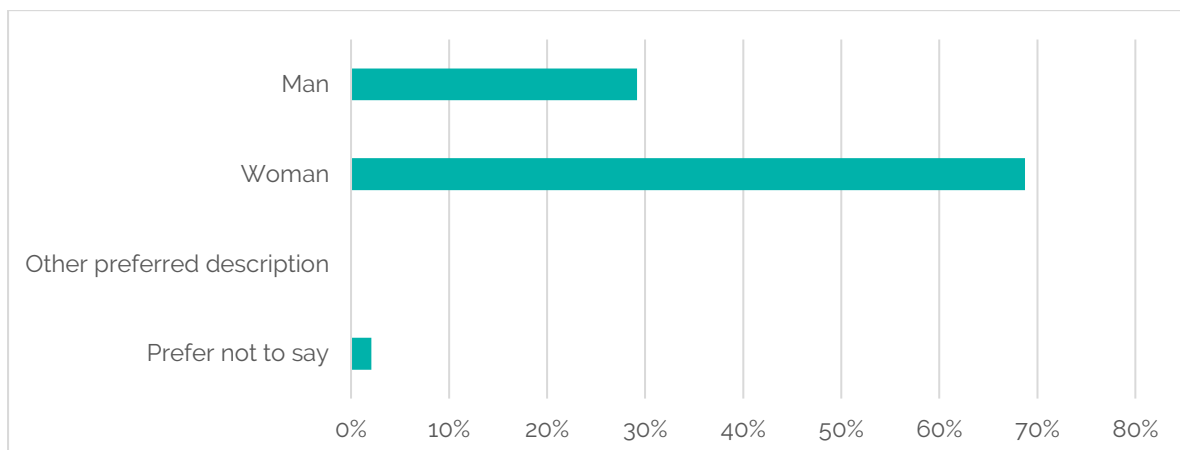

- Notary - Individuals authorised by the Master of the Faculties.

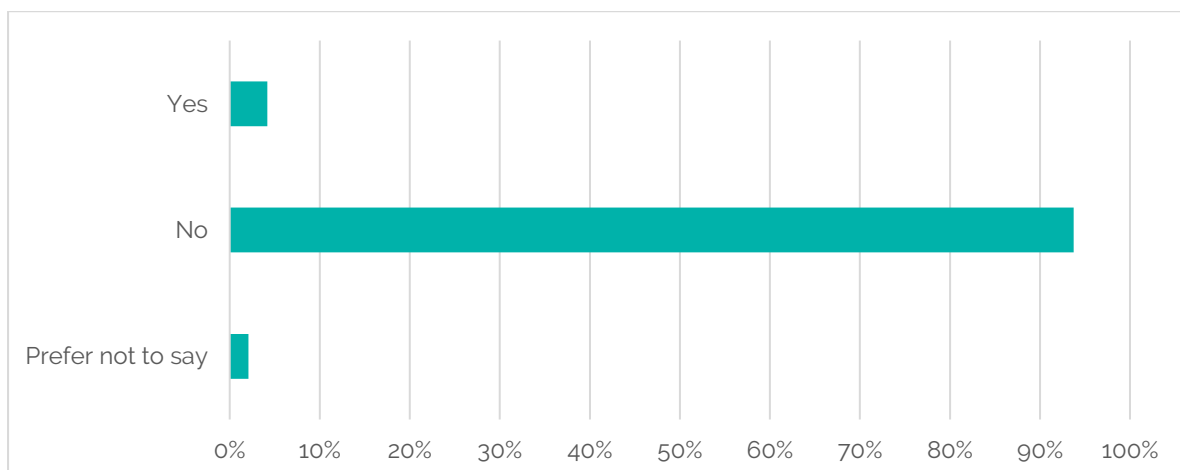
Question 2: Which age group are you in?



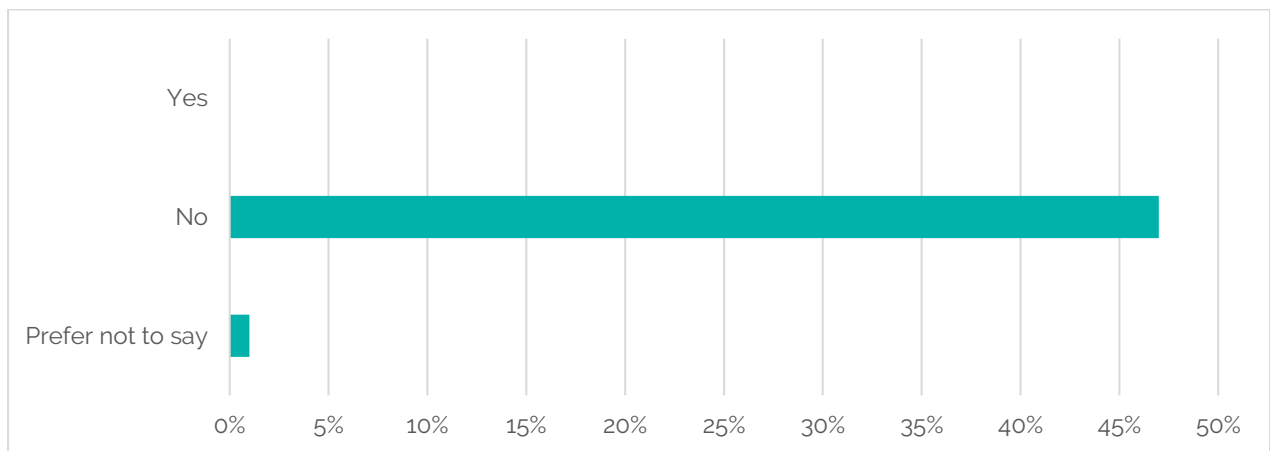
Question 3: Which gender do you identify with?



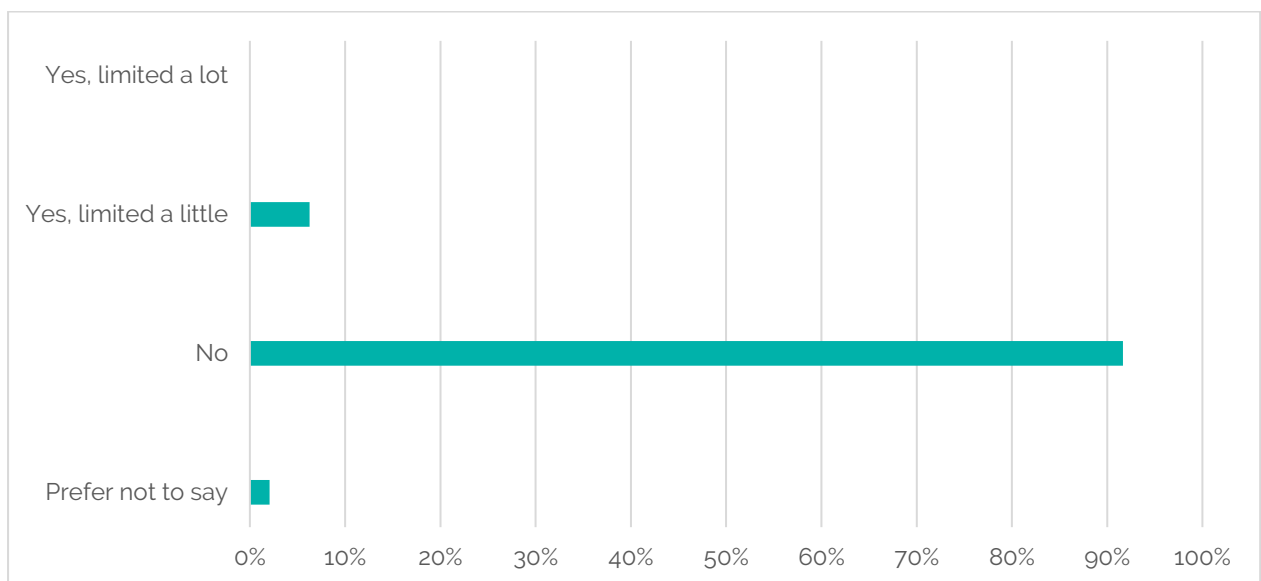
Question 4: Do you consider your gender identity to be different from your registered sex at birth?



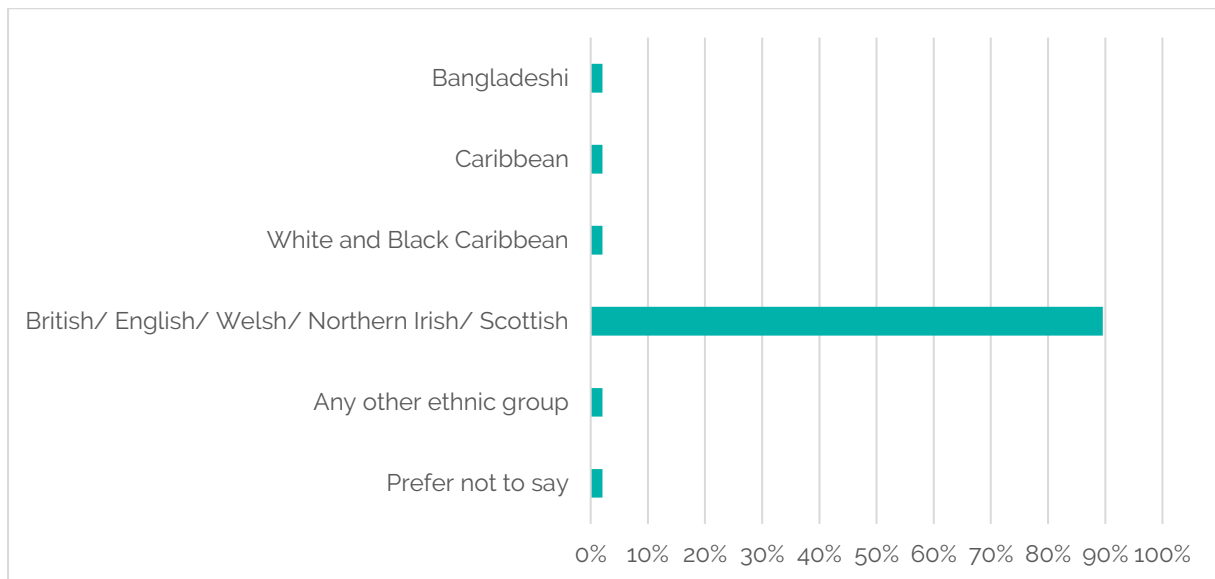
Question 5: Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?



Question 6: Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?



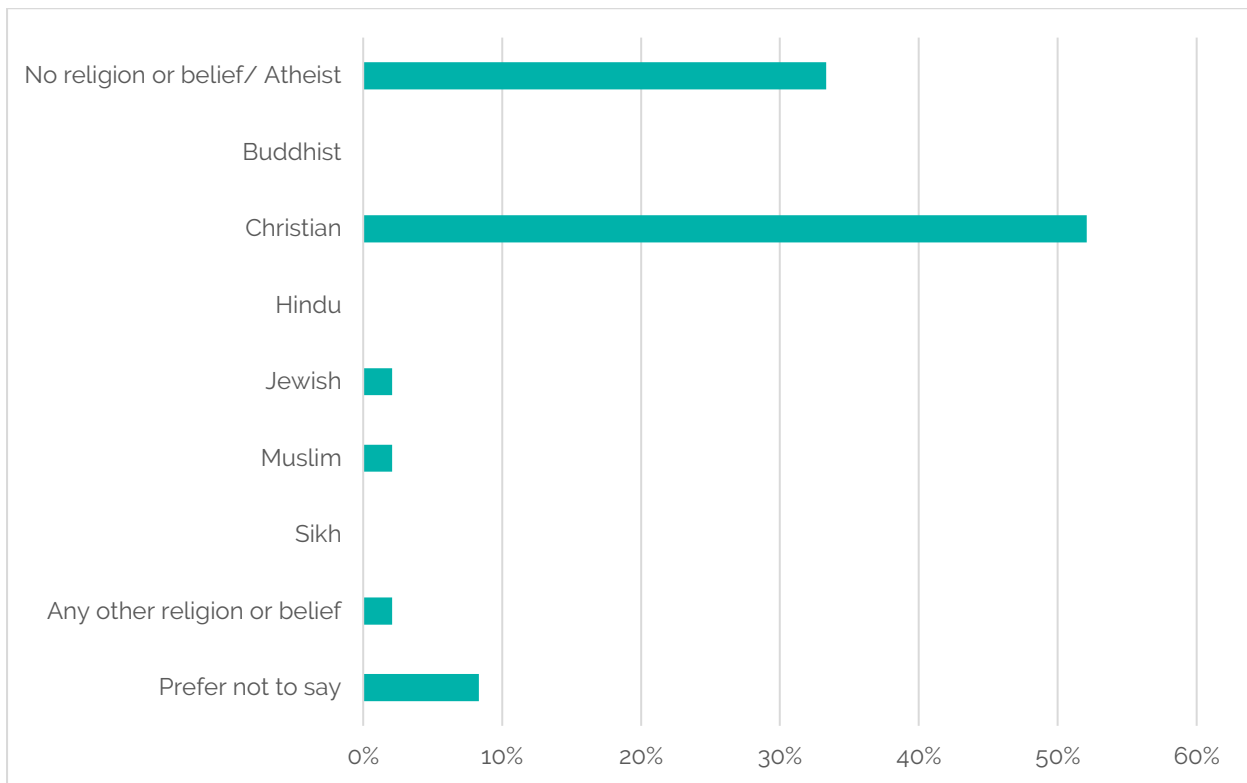

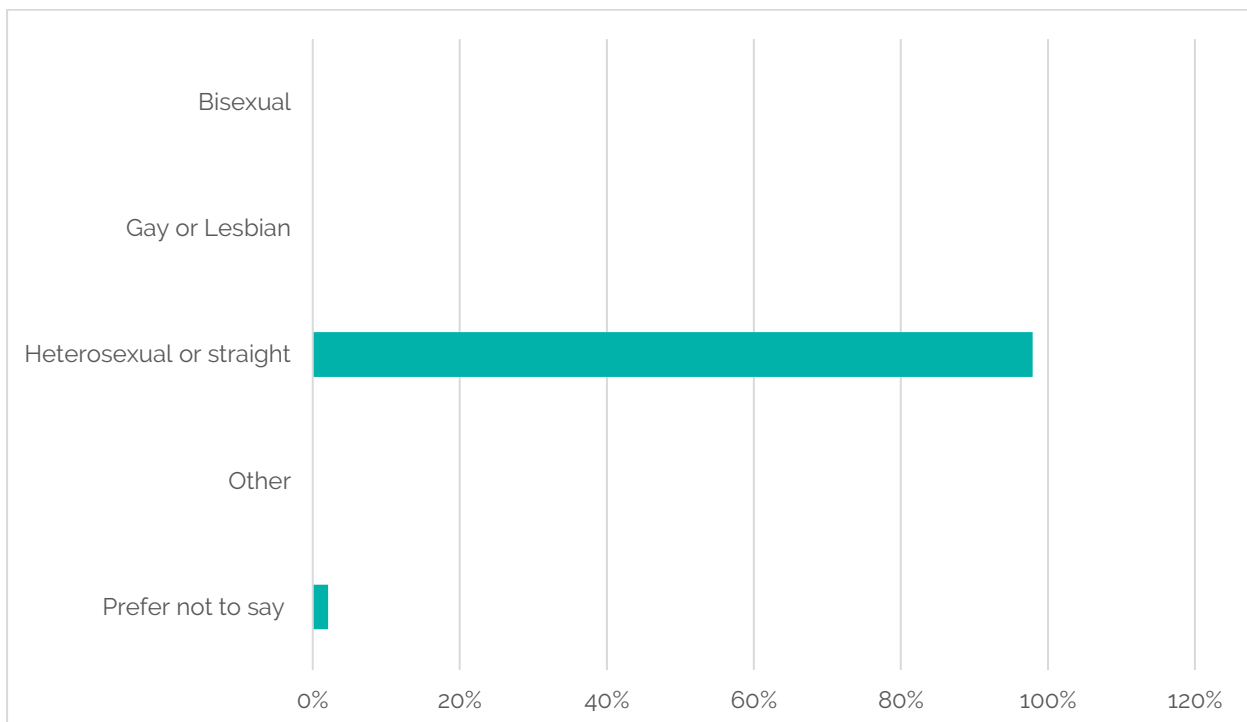

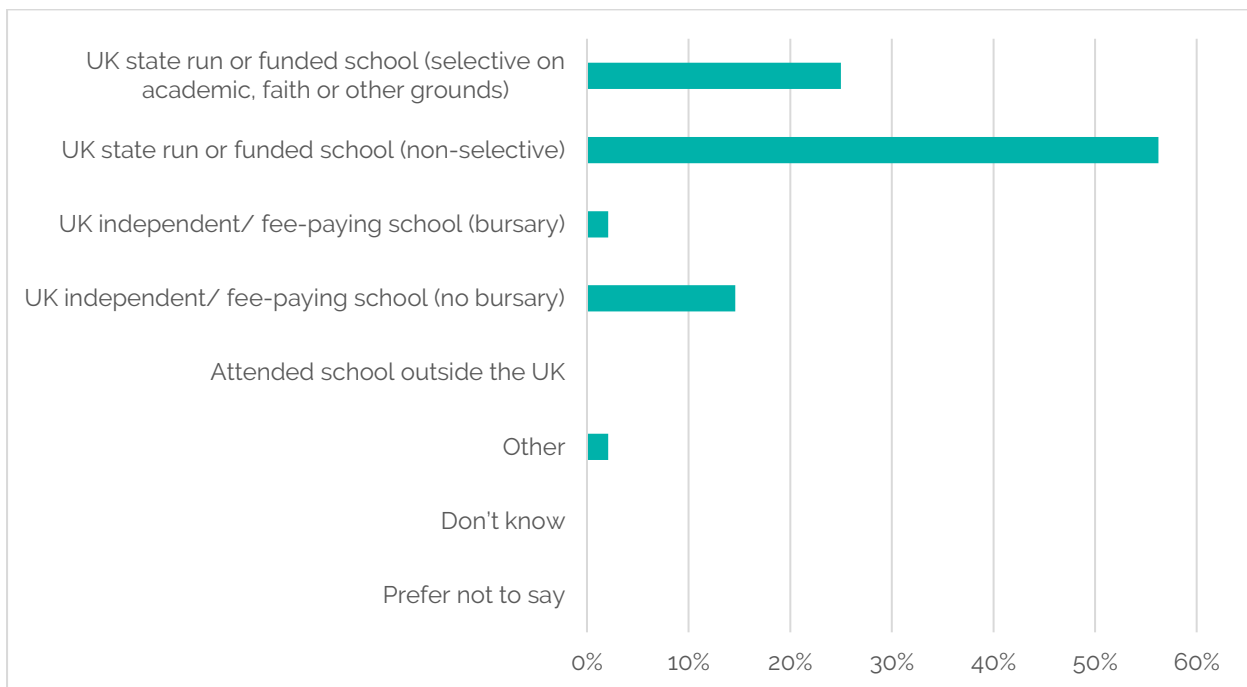

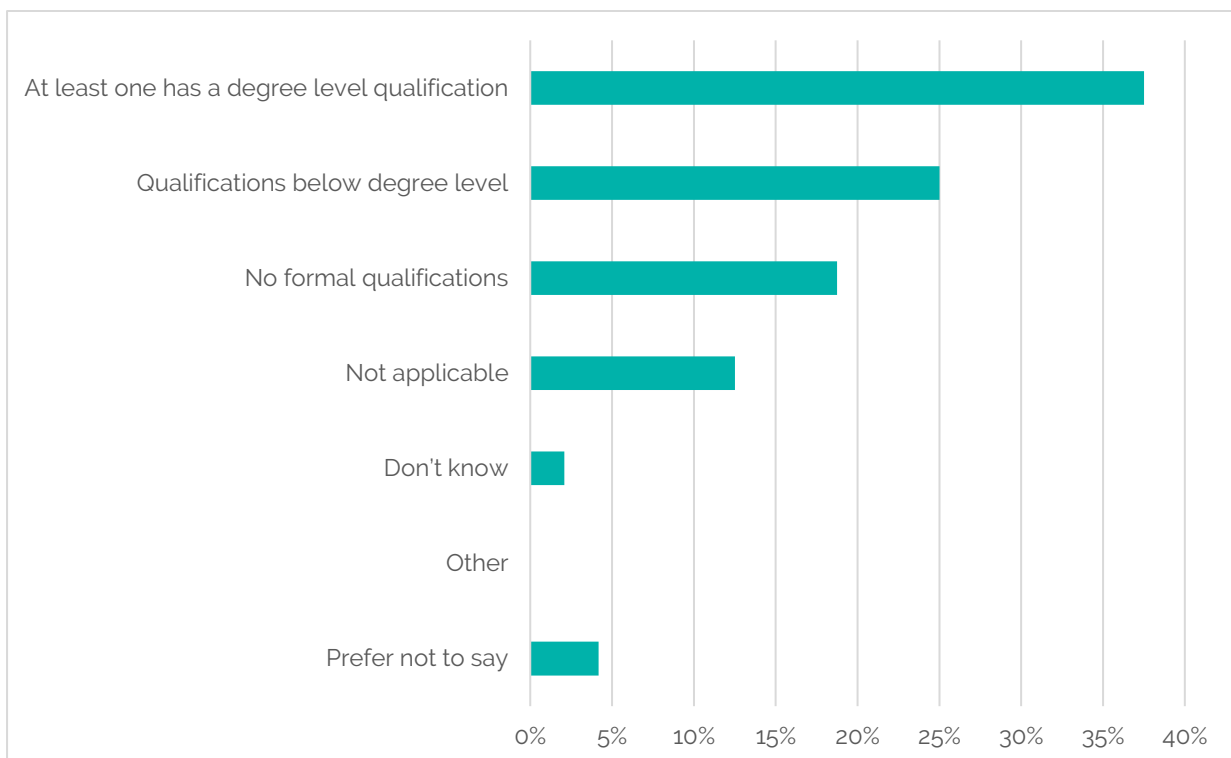

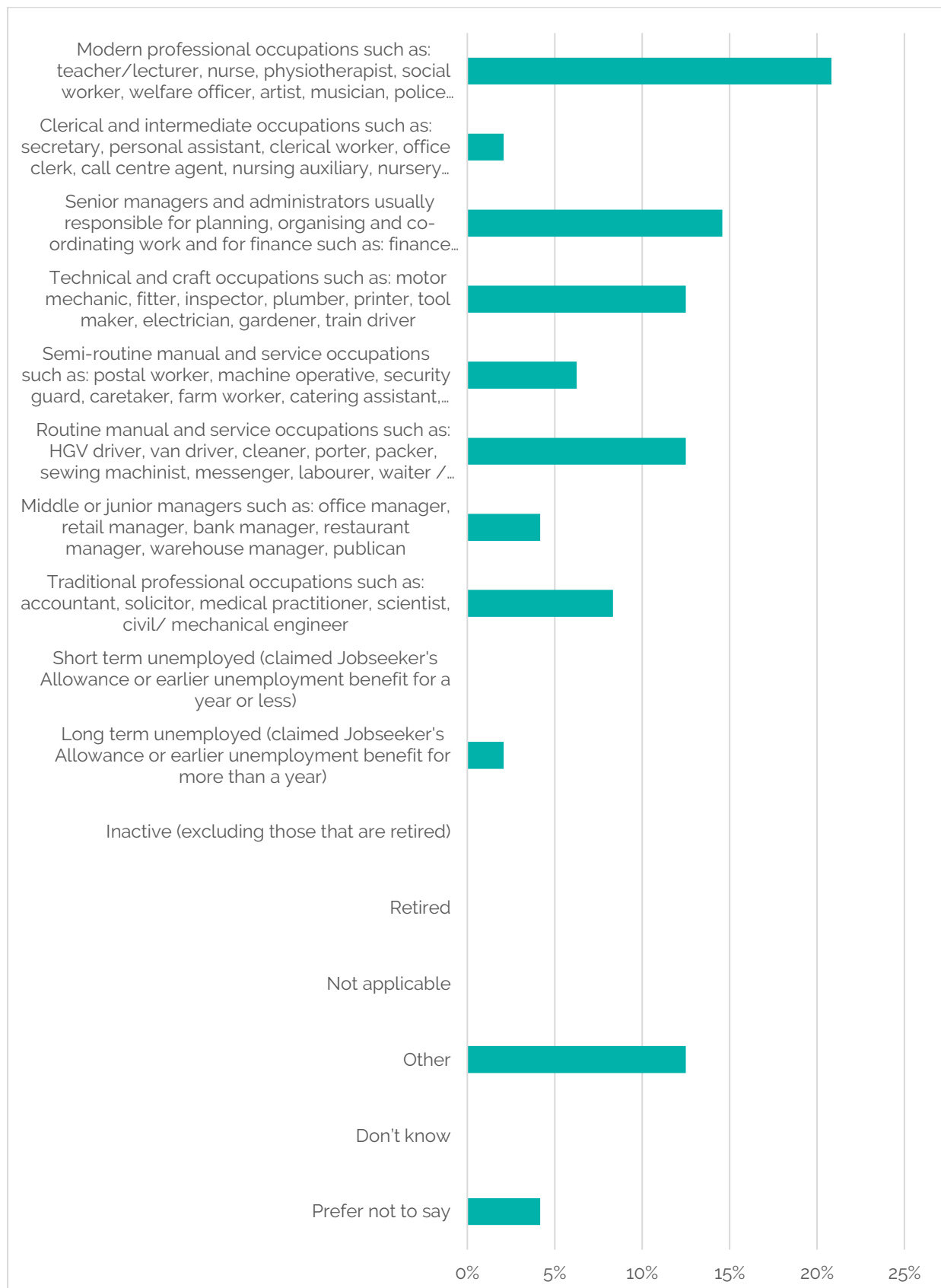
Question 10: What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages between the ages 11 and 16?



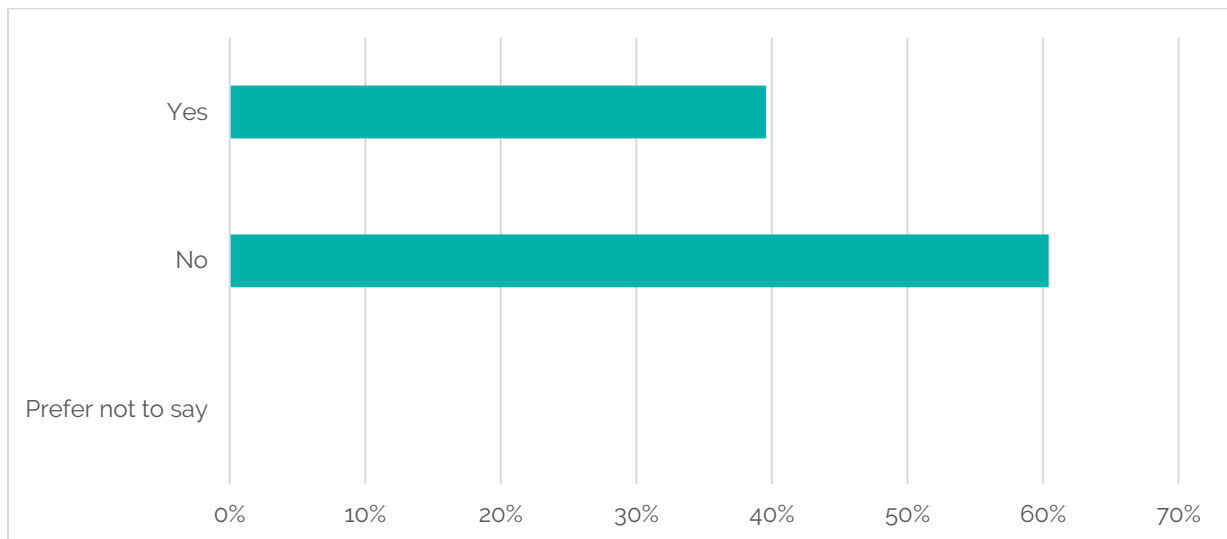
Question 11: What is the highest level of qualifications achieved by either of your parent(s) or guardian(s) by the time you were 18?
